**DEEMING** it necessary to to urgently open the registration process for the admission test to the First Cycle Degree Programme in Nursing for A.Y. 2025/2026, scheduled for 10 September

2025, in order to allow candidates to submit their application and indicate their preferences regarding the course locations;

## DECREES

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO THE  
THREE-YEAR DEGREE COURSE IN  
--- NURSING ---  
A.Y. 2025/2026**

**ART. 1 – ANNOUNCEMENT AND AVAILABLE PLACES**

The competitive examination for admission to the three-year Degree Course in Nursing, established and activated at the University of Campania “Luigi Vanvitelli” for the Academic Year 2025/2026, is hereby announced. As defined by Rector’s Decree No. 524 dated 15 July 2025, concerning the determination of the University’s educational capacity, the **provisional total number of available places is 20 (twenty)**, divided as follows:

- a) **10 places** exclusively reserved for EU citizens and non-EU citizens residing in Italy, pursuant to Article 39, Paragraph 5 of Legislative Decree No. 286/1998, as amended by Article 26 of Law No. 189/2002;
- b) **10 places** reserved for non-EU citizens residing abroad, who are not included under Art. 39, Par. 5 of Legislative Decree No. 286/1998.

The final quantification and distribution of available places—including any potential reduction compared to the figures indicated in this article— will be announced by subsequent provision, subject to the determinations made by the Ministry of University and Research and the Campania Region.

**ART. 2 – ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

EU citizens and non-EU citizens residing in Italy, pursuant to Art. 39, Par. 5 of Legislative Decree No. 286/1998 as amended by Art. 26 of Law No. 189/2002<sup>1</sup> cited above, who hold a second-level secondary school diploma of at least four years’ duration, or an equivalent qualification, as well as those who will obtain such diploma by the end of the 2024/2025 school year, may submit an application to participate in the selection process for the **10 places referred to in letter a)** of the previous article.

Only non-EU citizens residing abroad who are not included under the aforementioned Art. 39, Par. 5 of Legislative Decree No. 286/1998 and who comply with the interministerial provisions governing the procedures for entry, residence, and enrolment of foreign/international students in higher education programmes in Italy for the A.Y. 2025/2026, as published on the website of the Ministry of University and Research at [www.mur.gov.it](http://www.mur.gov.it), are eligible to apply for the **10 places referred to in letter (b)** of the previous article.

**ART. 3 - PROCEDURES FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SELECTION PROCESS**

To be admitted to the selection process, candidates applying for the **10 (ten) places reserved exclusively for EU citizens and non-EU citizens residing in Italy, pursuant to Art. 39, Par. 5 of Legislative Decree No. 286/1998, as amended by Art. 26 of Law No. 189/2002**, must submit their application using the University’s online services credentials, exclusively via the digital procedure (*website: [www.unicampania.it](http://www.unicampania.it) → [Servizi per studenti](#) > [Concorsi on-line](#) – click on > [ACCEDI](#)* and, once you have chosen the competition you wish to participate in, select **category 995**). **Applications must be submitted starting from the day following the publication of this call and no later than 5 September 2025.**

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<sup>1</sup> Foreign nationals holding a residence permit or a permit for subordinate or self-employment, for family reasons, for political asylum, for humanitarian protection, or for religious reasons, as well as foreign nationals who have been legally residing in Italy for at least one year and hold a secondary school qualification obtained in Italy, and foreign nationals—regardless of their place of residence—who hold final diplomas from Italian schools abroad or from foreign or international schools operating in Italy or abroad, subject to bilateral agreements or special regulations for the recognition of qualifications, and who meet the general conditions required for entry for study purposes.

To be admitted to the selection process, candidates applying for the **10 (ten) places reserved exclusively for non-EU citizens residing abroad**, who are not included under Art. 39, Par. 5 of Legislative Decree No. 286/1998, must submit their application using the University's online service credentials, exclusively via the digital procedure (*website: [www.unicampania.it](http://www.unicampania.it) → [Servizi per studenti](#) > [Concorsi on-line](#) –click on > [ACCEDI](#) and, once you have chosen the competition you wish to participate in, select **category 997***). **Applications must be submitted starting from the day following the publication of this call and no later than 5 September 2025.**

For users who do not have credentials, it is necessary to obtain them by following the registration procedure described in the "[Guide to Registering for University Web Services](#)".

To participate in the selection process, candidates are required—under penalty of exclusion—to pay a non-refundable fee of **€ 100.00**. Payment must be made by **5 September 2025**, following the generation of the PagoPA notice through the online application system.

This payment can be made through both physical and online channels of banks and other Payment Service Providers (PSP), such as bank agencies, home banking, ATMs, SISAL, Lottomatica and Banca 5 points of sale, using the Pago-PA payment notice, which will be generated as part of the aforementioned online procedure for registering for the competition.

For this purpose, a dedicated guide titled "[Guide to Online Registration for Admission to Restricted-Access Degree Programmes \(with options\)](#)" is available in the "Concorsi on-line" section of the University website. This guide is intended to assist users during the registration process required for generating the PagoPA payment notice.

The online application procedure will be automatically and strictly deactivated on **5 September 2025**. After this deadline, it will no longer be possible to complete the application for participation in the selection process or to generate the PagoPA bank payment notice required for the payment of the participation fee.

Registration for the selection process will be considered complete only after the payment of the aforementioned fee has been made, within the deadlines and according to the procedures indicated above.

This payment is non-refundable under any circumstances and is valid exclusively for the selection process for which the application is submitted.

The application submission procedure may be carried out 24 hours a day from any computer with internet access.

Failure to submit the application within the specified deadlines and in the manner indicated will result in exclusion from the selection process.

The Administration reserves the right, at any stage of the procedure, to verify the truthfulness of any substitute declarations of certification or affidavits submitted by candidates, in accordance with current legislation. Candidates must therefore provide all necessary information to enable the Administration to carry out the appropriate checks.

All candidates are admitted to the selection process on a provisional basis.

The Administration may, at any time and by means of a reasoned decree, exclude a candidate from the competition due to failure to meet the prescribed requirements.

#### **ART. 4 - ADMISSION TEST: DATE AND LOCATION**

1. The admission test for the three-year Degree Course in Nursing is scheduled for **10 September 2025, starting at 11:00 AM**. The duration of the test will be **100 (one hundred) minutes**.

The venue of the test will be announced with a subsequent notice, published on the University website, at the address [www.unicampania.it](http://www.unicampania.it). The participants in the admission test will be distributed by age, except for twins.

**2.** Candidates must report to the venue of the admission test at **09:00 AM**, bringing with them a valid identification document, the receipt confirming submission of the application form and the original receipt of payment of the participation fee. These documents must be presented in order to complete the required identification procedures.

**3.** Candidates who do not present a valid identification document will not be admitted to the test, unless they provide an official report of loss or theft issued by the competent authorities.

**4.** Candidates who fail to present either the application submission receipt or the original payment receipt will not be admitted to the test, unless their names appear on the official lists of eligible candidates prepared by the University.

**5.** Candidates who arrive after the completion of the identification procedures will not be admitted to the test.

**6.** Candidates who, for any reason, are absent from the test, after the closure of the aforementioned recognition operations, are considered to have renounced participation in the competition referred to in this announcement.

**This notice serves as official notification.**

#### **ART. 5 – ADMISSION TEST: CONTENTS – EVALUATION CRITERIA – ALLOCATED TIME FOR COMPLETION**

**1.** The admission test, prepared by CINECA on behalf of the University, is identical for access to all types of degree courses covered by this call for applications, in accordance with Art. 2, Par. 1, of Ministerial Decree No. 586/2025.

**2.** The test consists of **60 multiple-choice questions**, each offering five possible answers, of which the candidate must select only one, excluding those that are incorrect, arbitrary, or less probable. The questions cover the following subjects: reading comprehension and knowledge acquired through prior studies (4 questions), logical reasoning and problem-solving (5 questions), biology (23 questions), chemistry (15 questions), and physics and mathematics (13 questions). The content is based on the syllabus outlined in Annex “A” of Ministerial Decree No. 586 dated 6 August 2025.

**3.** For the evaluation of the admission test a maximum of **90 (ninety) points** are awarded and the following evaluation criteria are taken into account:

- a) 1.5 points for each correct answer;
- b) minus 0.4 (- 0.4) points for each wrong answer;
- c) 0 points for each answer not given.

Based on the score, calculated as provided in this article, a general merit ranking will be drawn up.

- In the event of a tie in the overall score, precedence will be given, in descending order, to the score obtained by the candidate in answering questions related to the following subjects: biology, chemistry, physics and mathematics, logical reasoning, and reading comprehension and knowledge acquired through prior studies.
- In the event of a tie between one or more candidates with disabilities holding a certificate of disability equal to or greater than 66%, or candidates with certification pursuant to Law No. 104 of 1992, Article 3, paragraph 3, and one or more candidates not belonging to the aforementioned categories, preference will be given to the candidate(s) with a certificate of disability equal to or greater than 66%, or with certification pursuant to Law No. 104 of 1992, Article 3, paragraph 3.

A candidate with a certificate of disability equal to or greater than 66%, or a candidate with

certification pursuant to Law No. 104 of 1992, Article 3, paragraph 3, who holds medical documentation—even if not updated due to limitations in the activities of the National Health Service (SSN) during the COVID-19 emergency—and who intends to assert such preference in the event of a tie with another candidate not belonging to the aforementioned categories, must submit to the University to which they have been “assigned,” within a mandatory period of fifteen (15) days starting from the date of assignment (including the first day), the certificate of disability equal to or greater than 66% or the certification pursuant to Law No. 104 of 1992, Article 3, paragraph 3. Failure to submit the required documentation within the specified timeframe will result in exclusion from the national ranking.

If the deadline expires without submission of the required documentation, the preferential status will not be taken into consideration.

- Outside of the aforementioned cases, in the event of a further tie, preference will be given to the candidate who is younger in age.

The admission test will be carried out even if the number of applications submitted for a specific degree course and location is equal to or less than the number of available places.

## **ART. 6 – ADMISSION TEST: PROCEDURES - CANDIDATE OBLIGATIONS - SUPERVISION**

1. At the time of the test, each candidate is given an envelope prepared by CINECA on behalf of the University.

Each package contains:

- a) a personal data sheet, without any identification code, which the candidate must fill in;
- b) the questions relating to the admission test, bearing the identification code of the package as well as n. 2 sheets dedicated to draft;
- c) an answer form, with the same identification code as the package;
- d) a sheet on which the identification code of the package is affixed as well as the indication of the University and the degree course to which the test refers;
- e) a sheet containing the anonymous credentials (User-ID and Password) through which the Candidate, after correcting the test, will be able to access a web page - corresponding to a URL (also present on the sheet) - where he can view:
  - 1. his test, in .html format, with an indication of the correct answers he should have provided;
  - 2. the score obtained;
  - 3. the scan of his answer form.

**The replacement that may become necessary during the test, even of only one of the documents indicated in points b), c) and e) entails the complete replacement of the package, as they are distinguished by the same identification code of the package.**

Any corrections or signs made by the candidate on the personal data sheet do not entail its replacement. The replacement of the personal data sheet is provided only where the signs or corrections made by the candidate involve an objective difficulty in identifying the candidate: in that case, the Commission will replace the personal data sheet by taking it from one of the reserve packages and the operation will acknowledge in the classroom minutes.

**The replacement of the personal data sheet never involves the replacement of the entire envelope.**

Before the start of the test, the President of the Examination Commission or the Classroom Manager draws four students from among the candidates present in the classroom and checks with them the integrity of the boxes, then opens them and distributes the packages in relation to the number of participants; gives each candidate the "*instruction sheet for completing the answer form*".

The “*instruction sheets for completing the answer form*” are made available to candidates before the test is carried out. The President of the Examination Committee or the Head of the classroom draws up and signs, for the operations carried out above, a specific declaration – **CLASSROOM REPORT** – which shows:

- 1.1) the verification of the integrity of the boxes;
- 1.2) the number of packages assigned;
- 1.3) the number of packages that may not have been used;

This declaration must also be signed by the four students drawn for the verification of the integrity of the packages containing the competition material.

In the event that one or more candidates report any irregularities regarding the package received, the President of the Examination Commission or the Head of the classroom checks its reliability and, if necessary, replaces the package itself. This operation must appear in the classroom minutes together with the related reasons. The replaced packages are not to be considered waste material but must be kept by the University.

Candidates, to fill in the answer form, must use only an indelible black pen, supplied by this University and must mark the chosen answer by putting the X sign in the corresponding box. It is possible to correct once and only once the answer that may have already been given to a question, taking care to completely black out the box previously drawn and choosing another: in any case, in order for the corresponding score to be assigned, there must be a mark (X) in only one of the five boxes.

**The answer form** provides, in correspondence with the progressive number of each question, a small circular figure that the student must cross only if he intends to give certainty of the will not to answer. This indication, once affixed, can no longer be changed; if the candidate does not put any sign in the answer boxes, even if he does not tick the circular figure, the answer is considered not given.

On the answer form - for the purpose of determining the relative score - there must be no signature or identifying mark of any kind, under penalty of cancellation of the test.

At the end of the test, the candidate is invited to reach a dedicated station equipped with a special pen, prepared by the Commission and placed at a suitable distance from it, and is invited to choose a pair of identical adhesive labels present therein. Each label must be applied, exclusively by the candidate, who must ensure that the alphanumeric codes printed on the labels of the chosen pair, on the answer form and on the personal data sheet correspond. The candidate must therefore obligatorily sign, on the duly completed personal data sheet, the declaration of truthfulness of the personal data and correspondence of the codes of the labels applied to the personal data sheet and to the answer form. At the end of these operations, the candidate must insert the personal data sheet in the sealed container present in the dedicated station and go to another dedicated station where he inserts the answer form in the closed container provided therein, taking care to insert the front of the form, containing the answers provided by the candidate, face down, facing down.

In addition to the answer form and the personal data sheet, the candidate must return to the Commission all the residual material contained in the package delivered at the beginning of the test.

The President of the Commission or the Head of the classroom then provides:

- to count the answer forms and to insert them in one or more containers that must be closed in the presence of the same candidates called to verify the integrity of the boxes or, in the event of their impossibility, in the presence of four other candidates drawn by lot;
- to insert all the personal data sheets in one or more containers that must be closed in the presence of the same candidates called to verify the integrity of the boxes or, in the event of their impossibility, in the presence of four other candidates drawn by lot;



- to affix a signature on the closing flaps of the containers and to invite the four students to put their signature on the same flaps;
- to pack other containers in which to enclose the packages returned because they have been replaced, the packages from which the personal data sheets for replacement have been taken as well as the unused packages, the declaration referred to in this article and a copy of the classroom report, with the classroom lists of candidates.

2. Candidates are strictly prohibited from keeping with them, during the tests, any bags or backpacks, books or notes, paper, personal tools suitable for writing (pens, pencils, etc.), mobile phones, "smartphones" and other electronic tools, including "smartwatches", "PDAs", tablets, headsets, webcams and portable personal computers of any type able to connect outside the classrooms, test locations, via "wireless" connections, or to the normal telephone network with UMTS, GPRS, GSM protocols, under penalty of cancellation of the test. Therefore, candidates are prohibited from introducing within the admission test venue: mobile phones, smartphones, smartwatches, PDAs, tablets, headsets, webcams and other similar tools. Candidates who are in possession of such equipment, must deliver them to the identification staff before entering the classroom or sector where the candidate was assigned to perform the test.

It is also forbidden to introduce manuals, school texts, handwritten notes and reference material and blank sheets. During the test, competitors are not allowed to communicate verbally or in writing, or to relate to others, except with the members of the Commission or the Supervisory Committee or with the technical-administrative staff responsible for supervision.

**If a candidate violates the provisions set out in this article, the test will be annulled by the Examination Commission, and the candidate will be excluded from the selection process.**

#### **ART. 7 – GROUNDS FOR CANCELLATION OF THE TEST FOR CANDIDATES**

The following circumstances will constitute grounds for cancellation of the test for candidates:

1. the performance of the test by the candidate in an exam room other than the one in which the candidate is enrolled in the room lists unless the variation has been authorized by the Examination Commission and this is acknowledged in the report;
2. the introduction and use in the classroom, by the candidate, of mobile phones, PDAs, smartphones, smartwatches, tablets, headsets, webcams or other similar equipment, manuals, school texts and / or even partial reproductions of them, handwritten notes and reference material, as already provided for in Paragraph 2 of Article 6 of this announcement;
3. the affixing on the answer form (both on the front and on the back) of the signature or marks of the candidate or a member of the Commission;
4. the interaction between candidates and/or attempts to copy and/or attempts to exchange any material, including the exchange of personal data and/or answer forms, in the possession of the candidates;
5. the use by the candidate, during the operations of inserting the personal data sheet and the answer form inside the containers used therein, of pens, pencils or any other suitable instrument for writing in order to make changes, additions and/or corrections to the answer form.

The cancellation of the test is ordered by the Commission. In the cases referred to in numbers 1), 2), 3) 4) and 5) CINECA does not determine the score of the cancelled test.

The test is also subject to cancellation in case of use by the candidate, after the end of the test, of pens, pencils or any other suitable writing instrument in order to make changes, additions and / or corrections to the answer form, and in the in the event that the personal data sheet shows deletions and / or abrasions or indicates data which, at the discretion of the Commission, do not allow the author of the paper to be traced with certainty.

## **ART. 8 - CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSION IN CHARGE OF THE ADMISSION TEST AND FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROCEDURE**

The Commission in charge of the admission test, appointed with a subsequent provision, is composed of the President, a teacher with teaching activities in the courses of the School Medicine and Surgery and of 4 (four) effective members plus two alternates, appointed from among all the teachers and researchers with teaching activities in the courses of the School of Medicine and Surgery. The Commission is given all responsibility for the regular performance of the test referred to herein, according to the methods and criteria set out in the Ministry of University and Research Decree No. 586/2025. The Commission in charge of the test is also responsible for the tasks that will be detailed in the appointment provision. All the operations carried out by the Commission in charge of the test must be reported in a special report, initialed on each sheet and signed by the President and by all the members of the Commission itself.

During the test, the aforementioned Commission is assisted in its tasks by a Supervisory Committee - also appointed with a subsequent provision - made up of teaching and/or research staff with teaching activities in the study courses of the School of Medicine and Surgery, with tasks of checking the regularity of the performance of the test and reporting any irregularities to the Commission, which will take the relevant decisions.

In the supervisory activity, the Commission will be supported not only by the aforementioned Supervisory Committee, but also by the University's technical-administrative staff in charge of this function, as well as by security guards.

Pursuant to art. 4 of Law No. 241 dated 7 August 1990 and subsequent amendments (New rules on administrative procedure and right of access to administrative documents) and the Regulation on transparency: discipline on administrative procedure and access (Rector's Decree No. 622 dated 26 July 2018), Dr. Santa Migliaccio, Head of the Section for Legal Aspects of Competitive Procedures and Student Litigation within the Student Career Management Division of this University, is appointed as the Responsible for the entire selection procedure, insofar as it does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Examination Commission.

The members of the Commission and the Supervisory Committee, the Responsible for the procedure and all the staff involved in any capacity in the supervision operations must, before conducting the admission test referred to in this announcement and after reviewing the printouts listing the names of the candidates admitted to the selection process, issue a declaration stating that they have no kinship or affinity relationship with any of the candidates up to and including the fourth degree, and that they do not hold any political office.

## **ART. 9 - RANKING**

Candidates are only eligible if they have obtained a score greater than zero (0) points; candidates who have not provided any answer to any question are not included in the ranking.

Based on the evaluation criteria referred to in Art. 5 of this call for applications, the University draws up two distinct rankings, one for EU citizens wherever they reside and non-EU citizens pursuant to Art. 26 of Law 189/2002, and the other for non-EU citizens residing abroad.

In both merit rankings, the candidates who achieve the highest positions, in accordance with the number of available places, will be declared winners. Any candidate who does not secure one of the available places will not be entitled to enrolment, without prejudice to any changes in the ranking as specified in Art. 12 below.

## **ART. 10 - PUBLICATION OF RANKINGS.**

The rankings referred to in the previous Art. 9 will be published on the University's website at [www.unicampania.it](http://www.unicampania.it) by **25 September 2025**.

Publication of rankings will constitute official notification to all concerned parties for all legal purposes; therefore, no personal communications or notifications will be sent to candidates.

## ART. 11 – DEADLINES FOR ENROLMENT

Candidates, taking into account the number of places available as indicated in Article 1 of this call, must register and submit their enrolment application **exclusively** according to the procedures outlined below, starting from **09:00 AM on 29 September and no later than 12:00 PM on 9 October 2025**.

Candidates must register and submit the enrolment application online, by accessing the student web services area on the [Online Enrolment page](#) using the same credentials previously used, and following the procedures outlined in the [Enrolment Guide \(for standard enrolments, course abbreviations, students who have withdrawn or whose previous academic career has lapsed, or incoming transfer students\) for limited access degree courses](#) or in the [Enrolment Guide for Transfers to a Limited Access Degree Course](#), both available at the aforementioned student web services link. When completing the application, candidates must select “Laurea Triennale” as the *Course Type* and enter the course code “B50 - CdL in Nursing” as the *Degree Course*.

For the Academic Year 2025/2026, the amount of the regional fee varies based on the applicant’s I.S.E.E. value. The applicable amounts and payment procedures for the regional fee can be found on the ADISURC website.

For information regarding the payment procedures of the regional fee, candidates may consult the [Tassa regionale per il diritto allo studio](#) page on the ADISURC website, unless otherwise indicated by a notice published on the University’s website.

**During the ONLINE REGISTRATION procedure for the enrolment application, candidates are required to upload the following documents:**

- A valid identification document (mandatory and blocking upload);
- Tax code (mandatory and blocking upload);
- A passport-style photograph (minimum resolution: 266x354 pixels) clearly showing the candidate’s face in the foreground (mandatory but non-blocking upload, to be completed in any case within 30 days from the date of application registration).

**During the ONLINE SUBMISSION PROCEDURE of the enrolment application, candidates must upload the following documents in their personal web area, under the section “Career / Career Attachments”:**

- Enrolment application previously registered, printed and signed (Type of attachment: *Enrolment application*);
- Payment receipt of the first enrolment fee (Type of attachment: *Payment receipt of the first enrolment fee/virtual stamp duty*);
- Regional Tax Payment Receipt (Type of Attachment: *Regional Tax Payment Receipt*).

The enrolment application will be deemed duly submitted only if, within the specified enrolment deadlines, all required documents—namely, a valid identification document, tax code, signed enrolment application, and proof of payment of the enrolment fee (or alternatively, a virtual stamp and telematic receipt of payment of the Regional Tax)—have been correctly uploaded via the designated online procedure. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in forfeiture of the right to enroll.

Please note that the exact date and time of each upload is recorded in the University’s database; therefore, any uploads completed after the deadline will not be considered valid for the purposes of enrolment.

It is further specified that the examination also serves to assess the candidate’s possession of an adequate initial preparation. In accordance with the academic regulations of the Degree Courses in Nursing, for enrolled students, the scores obtained in the following

subjects included in the admission test —“Biology”, “Chemistry”, and “Physics and Mathematics”— will be recorded.

**Any Additional Educational Obligations (Obbligo Formativo Aggiuntivo)** will be fulfilled by the student admitted to the three-year Degree Course in accordance with the provisions set forth in the Course’s academic regulations and the guidelines established by the University.

Applications or documentation sent by post, PEC (Certified E-mail) or fax will not be accepted.

**Failure to complete enrolment within the mandatory deadlines will result in forfeiture of the status of “winner” candidate, regardless of the reason.**

## **ART. 12 - SCROLLS IN THE RANKING LISTS**

Should any places remain vacant after the enrolment deadline, they will be filled through the publication of **up to a maximum number of three** ranking lists for the reassignment of available positions.

If, upon the conclusion of the enrolment period, there are still unfilled places, the Students’ Office for the Degree Courses in Health Professions will proceed with the reassignment of places by scrolling the general merit ranking list.

In particular, on 15 October 2025 the Students’ Office will publish the list of candidates eligible for enrolment following the first reassignment of places (first ranking list scroll).

Eligible candidates must complete their enrolment starting from 09:00 AM on 16 October 2025 and no later than 12:00 PM on 23 October 2025, in accordance with the procedures outlined in the previous article.

If, at the end of the enrolment period for candidates eligible through the first reassignment, there are still unfilled places, a second reassignment of places will be carried out.

Accordingly, on 28 October 2025, the Students’ Office will publish the list of candidates eligible for enrolment following the second ranking list scroll.

Eligible candidates must complete their enrolment starting from 09:00 AM on 29 October 2025 and no later than 12:00 PM on 5 November 2025, in accordance with the procedures outlined in the previous article.

If, at the end of the enrolment period for candidates eligible through the second reassignment, there are still unfilled places, a third reassignment of places will be carried out.

On 10 November 2025, the Students’ Office will publish the list of candidates eligible for enrolment following the third ranking list scroll.

Eligible candidates must complete their enrolment starting from 09:00 AM on 11 November 2025 and no later than 12:00 PM on 13 November 2025, in accordance with the procedures outlined in the previous article.

Should there still be vacant places after the three reassignment rounds, the University reserves the right to publish additional ranking list scrolls, subject to a justified administrative decision.

Once all reassignment rounds provided for in this article have been completed, and if places remain available due to a lack of eligible candidates, the University will apply any further provisions set forth in the forthcoming Ministerial Decree defining the procedures and content of the admission test for Degree Courses in Health Professions.

The lists of candidates eligible for enrolment through ranking list scrolls will be published on the University’s website at [www.unicampania.it](http://www.unicampania.it)

Such publication will constitute official notification to all concerned parties for all legal purposes; therefore, no individual communications or personal notifications will be sent to candidates.

**Failure to complete enrolment within the deadlines specified above will result in forfeiture of the right to enroll for the A.Y. 2025/2026 in the Degree Course covered by this call for applications.**

## **ART. 13 - CANDIDATES WITH DISABILITIES AND/OR SPECIFIC LEARNING DISORDERS (SLD)**

1. Candidates with disabilities, pursuant to Articles 16 and 20 of Law No. 104 of 5 February 1992, as amended by Law No. 17 of 28 January 1999, may request the necessary aids based on the type and degree of disability, as well as the possible granting of additional time for the completion of the test. These candidates are entitled to additional time not exceeding 50% of the standard duration of the admission test referred to in this call for applications.
2. Candidates holding a certificate of disability or a certification pursuant to Law No. 104/1992 must promptly submit to the University, for the purpose of organizing the test, the original or an authenticated copy of the certification (on plain paper), issued by the competent territorial Medical Commission, attesting to the type and/or degree of recognized disability.
3. Candidates diagnosed with Specific Learning Disorders (SLD), certified pursuant to Law No. 170/2010, must submit appropriate certification issued no more than three years prior, or after reaching the age of eighteen, by Local Health Authorities or by institutions and professionals accredited by the National Health Service (SSN). These candidates are entitled to additional time equal to 30% of the standard duration of the admission test.
4. Candidates with disabilities or SLD residing in foreign countries who wish to benefit from the measures outlined in the preceding paragraphs must submit certification attesting to their condition, issued in their country of residence, accompanied by a sworn translation in Italian or English. The University bodies responsible for evaluating such documentation will verify that the foreign certification confirms a condition of disability or SLD recognized under Italian law.
5. Applications for the provision of necessary aids and/or the granting of additional time must be submitted, together with the appropriate medical documentation referred to in paragraphs 2, 3, and 4 above, by the deadline indicated in this call for applications, via the online procedure available at the following link:

**Applications submitted in a manner that does not comply with the provisions of this article will not be taken into consideration.**

## **ART. 14 - PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA**

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the GDPR - EU General Data Protection Regulation no. 2016/679, the personal data provided by candidates will be collected at the Università degli Studi della Campania "Luigi Vanvitelli", for the purposes of managing the selection and will be processed on paper and through an automated database.

The data controller is the Rector of this University.

At any time, the data subject may exercise his/her rights vis-à-vis the data controller pursuant to Articles 15 to 22 of the aforementioned EU Regulation 2016/679, including the right to access the data, the right to rectify, update, complete or erase any data that is erroneous, incomplete or collected in terms that do not comply with the law, as well as the right to object for legitimate reasons to its processing.

Candidates are entitled to exercise their right of access to the documents and records related to the selection procedure (limited to documents and records held by this University and within its competence), via the web page [Document Access Request](#), in accordance with Law No. 241/1990 and subsequent amendments, and in compliance with the University's Regulation implementing the aforementioned Law No. 241/1990, as referenced in the preamble of this notice and issued by Rector's Decree No. 622 dated 26 July 2018.

## **ART. 16 – FINAL PROVISIONS**

For all matters not expressly provided for in this call for applications, reference shall be made to the legislative, regulatory, and ministerial provisions cited in the preamble.

This University reserves the right to exclude, at any stage of the selection procedure, candidates participating in the admission test governed by this call for applications, due to non-compliance with the provisions herein, failure to meet the indicated deadlines, or lack of the required qualifications.

**The mandatory nature of compliance with the deadlines and provisions** set forth in this call for applications is hereby reiterated.

## **ART. 17 - JURISDICTION**

Appeals against the content of this notice may be lodged with the competent Regional Administrative Court (T.A.R.) within 60 days from the date of its publication.
